### RACE / REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**Race Date:** Saturday, September 8th, 2018

**Place:** Brigham City – City Center Plaza 58 North Main St.

**Parking:** Parking is extremely limited in Downtown Brigham City because of Peach Days activities. There are parking restrictions for the race. You are **NOT ALLOWED** to park in the following places:

Main Street or in parking lots with main street access only

In the Hampton Inn parking lot

City Offices Parking Lot (20 North Main Street)

Parking lot south of the County Courthouse

You can park:

Box Elder County Justice Court and Motor Vehicle building parking lot (accessed from 100 west) across the street from the academy building

Along 1<sup>st</sup> east and 1<sup>st</sup> west (legal street parking only)

**NEW THIS YEAR SHUTTLE:** There will be a shuttle for the race from the USU Brigham City Parking Lot (1000 South Main Street) on a loop for the Peach Days 10K race. They will be taking runners to the start line from 7:00 am to 7:45 am. The loop will be from the USU Brigham City parking lot to the Academy Building to drop runners off then back to the USU Brigham City Parking Lot. This will be the only bus running during this time and it will be specifically for the racers. To get back to your car after the race is over in the Shopko parking lot the shuttle pick up will be 100 North and 100 East from 8:00 am to the end of the parade. When the parade finishes it will return to the normal route and pickup will become 100 N and Main St in the H&R Block building parking lot.

**Start time:** 8:00 am for the 10K race, 8:10 am to 8:15 am for the 5K and then the Mile Race around 8:20 am for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will be while the 10K and 5K race is going on. Be there around 6:45 am to start to pick up your race number and shirt.

**Pre-registration:** Download the following registration form, fill it out, and then mail by Sept 1st. Registrations need post marked on or before Sept 1st. Registrations post marked after that date will need to pay the day of registration cost.

**Day-of Registration:** Race Day registration will start at 6:45 am. Registration will close at 7:45 am. We will **NOT** be doing a Friday night preregistration pickup or registration. It will all be done on Saturday.

**Awards:** This will depend on the number who sign up in the 5K and 10K races.

I assume all risks associated with travel to and from the event and participation in the event, including but not limited to falls, contact with other participants and vehicles, effects of the weather, and any and all course hazards. I am fully aware that participating in a road race along city streets and a parade route is a dangerous activity and I voluntarily participate in said activity with the knowledge of the danger involved and hereby agree to accept and assume any and all risk of injury. I am aware that at intersections where police are present and at intersections where police are not present I am responsible to obey all traffic laws and I am responsible for my safety at intersections along the route. I am fully aware that participation is strenuous and may be hazardous. I certify that I, or my minor child am/is physically fit and sufficiently trained to complete and participate in the event, and I agree to abide by all rules and by any decision of a race official relative to my ability to safely compete the run. I authorize all above-named parties to use photos, video, or other record of this event, and any information contained in my application, for any purpose whatsoever, without any consideration due to me.
